UNFINISHED BUSINESS

1. Storm Water/Infrastructure Maintenance Monthly Report

A copy of this report is attached to these minutes. Mr. Cinquepalmi said that in addition to the work contained in the report, they have repaired 5 sink holes in the last two weeks and two more will be repaired by the end of the week.

2. 2017 Projects

Mr. Petrusky stated that the 2017 projects are complete and asked if there was a list of projects for 2018. Mr. Schmitzer said that we don't have any projects listed for 2018 currently; it's more maintenance of projects that we have done over the past few years. He said that he would be happy to prepare a list of maintenance projects for the next meeting. He said that they are working with Soil and Water to do a review for us, check for maintenance items that need to be done and we will then address those.

Mr. Langshaw said that Mr. and Mrs. Jencson are in the audience and asked Mr. Schmitzer for an update on their property. Mr. Schmitzer said that he spoke with Mr. Jencson and explained that there won't be any additional work done for a month or so due to the rain. He said that Mr. Jencson brought some additional concerns to his attention and said that he will address these concerns by the end of the week and will notify all involved via email.

Mr. Kasaris asked about the status of the people who live around the Biro ditch. Mr. Schmitzer said that this can be one of the projects that we can have Soil and Water take a look at and let us know if there are any issues that are visible.

Mr. Petrusky asked to have this item on the Stormwater Agenda updated to read: **2017 Maintenance Projects.**

NEW BUSINESS

1. Proposed Ordinance 18-41 -1481.08 Management of Systems amendments

Mr. Schmitzer said that this came out of discussions held with the administration about providing a funding source to help Home Owners Association's (HOA) with their maintenance of storm water facilities. He said that every 3 years we inspect all of the basins throughout the city. Each of the owners of these stormwater facilities receive a report from Soil and Water on behalf of the city. Many of the maintenance items are things such as invasive plant species, dredging, erosion, etc. Some of the HOA's have no money at all set aside for these long term maintenance items. Therefore the city is going to start a fund for this type of work. It will be an application process to his office for consideration of funding to

assist with these maintenance activities. This legislation allows us to start the fund, start the application process, and allow for an appeal process if someone is denied funding.

Mr. Langshaw stated that this provides for the opportunity to educate the HOA's in what their responsibilities are regarding storm water maintenance.

Moved by Mr. Petrusky, seconded by Mr. Langshaw to remove this item from committee and recommend approval to Council. Roll Call: Yeas: 3. Nays: 0. **Motion carried.**
