

STREETS COMMITTEE MINUTES
JUNE 4, 2019

The Streets Committee meeting was held on June 4, 2019 at North Royalton City Hall, 14600 State Road. The meeting was called to order at 6:18 p.m.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Moved by Mr. Nickell, seconded by Mr. Antoskiewicz to **approve the May 7, 2019 Streets Committee minutes**. Roll Call: Yeas: 3. Nays: 0. **Motion carried.**

UNFINISHED BUSINESS

1. North Royalton Alternative Transportation Study

Mr. Cinquepalmi said that there is a preconstruction meeting scheduled for June 11, 2019 at the ODOT offices in Garfield Hts.

3. 2017 Infrastructure Program.

4. 2018 Infrastructure Program

Mr. Cinquepalmi said that Akins Road between Edgerton and York Roads has been repaved and will be fog sealed and striped within the next few weeks.

5. Rt. 82 Widening Project

Mr. Cinquepalmi said that the paving is almost completed. They are going to keep the top two inches off until both sides are done. The south side of Rt. 82 from the apartments to DiGioia's lot past the Service Center has been paved. This means that everything underground is done. They are now building the catch basins. When this is done they will move traffic from the north side to the south side and then they will tear out this side. This should be happening within the next few weeks. Mr. Nickell asked how they are going to transition the traffic back on to the old pavement. Mr. Cinquepalmi said that they originally were not going down to York Road but they wanted to get all of the water main and all of the gas main in one run. He said that he heard that when they get the first half done up to DiGioia's property, they are going to put the rest of Rt. 82 back to normal for the winter until next spring. Discussion on various aspects of the pavement transition occurred. Mr. Langshaw asked if there were still plans for some repairs on Abbey Road after the intersections are complete. Mayor Stefanik said that we are going to apply for Issue 1 funding again this year.

NEW BUSINESS

1. Appropriation Amendment.

Mayor Stefanik said that we want to take \$300,000 from our income tax receipts this year and put it towards Albion Road. He said that we only did repairs on North Akins instead of a resurfacing and also we backed out all of the crack sealing out of all the projects and are doing it inhouse. Therefore, we were able to save enough money to do all of Albion Road this year. Mr. Nickell asked what the repairs will entail. Mayor Stefanik said it will be a complete resurface from W. 130th to Ridge Road using the same process that was used on Bunker Road. Mr. Nickell asked how they will address the dip caused by the heavy trucks. Mayor Stefanik said they will be doing replacement there as well. Mr. Cinquepalmi said that we put money in for base repairs. Mr. Cinquepalmi provided an overview of the milling process used on Bunker Road. He said they mill 3 inches off, then they proof roll it with a heavy truck. If there are any

spots they are then marked out and they come back and go down 12 inches and put down asphalt. Then they put down a one inch chip seal which acts as a barrier and then they put 3 inches of asphalt down. When they are done with the final pass, we have the street striping company right behind them to stripe the road.

Mr. Nickell said that people were not happy with the berms when we did Abbey Road. He asked if we were doing something different on Albion Road. Mr. Cinquepalmi said that he has been looking for sandstone material that has held up well in the past and has found it. He said that they used it on Wallings Road last month from Ridge Road to the corporation line. He said that we have had a lot of rain and he is happy with how this material is holding up.

4/29/19-Mon.

Crack Seal-Julia & Jay.

Catch Basins-pour new concrete in 4 basins on Glen Abbey.

Storm Water-repair two basins on Dublin Dr. [4853 & 4858].

4/30/19-Tue.

Crack Sealing-James Dr.

Catch Basins-Glen Abbey set up the last 4 basins for a Wednesday pour.

Storm Water-Ditching W130th, [10315 to 10715].

5/1/19-Wed.

Catch Basins-pour new concrete in the last 4 basins on Glen Abbey.

Asphalt-C. W. D. sent two crews out to repair all the water main breaks throughout the city. One crew will be tearing out, while the asphalt crew follows. We had a total of 14 water main breaks this winter.

5/2/19-Thur.

Catch Basins-return to Stoney Creek there are 5 basins left to repair. This will complete our work in Hunters Creek.

Asphalt- finish the C.W.D. digs, [5 digs left to asphalt].

Storm Water-8478 Royalhaven Dr., ditch out in front of the property in order to lower the pipe, [water was backing up].

5/3/19-Fri.

Catch Basins-continue on Stoney Creek.

Patching.

Storm Water-clean and open all our storm structure throughout the city.

5/6/19-Mon.

Crack Sealing-finish Julia Dr.

Storm Water-repair the pipe at 10505 Sprague Rd. then ditch out in front of the property.

Catch Basins-continue on Stoney Creek.

5/7/19-Tue.

Crack Sealing-Pinestream Development.

Catch Basins-Stoney Creek, set up the last 5 basins for a Wednesday pour.

Berming- Wallings Rd. [between Ridge & State].

5/8/19-Wed.

Catch Basins-Stoney Creek, pour new concrete in 5 basins.

Berming-Wallings Rd. [between Ridge & State].

Mowing-North Akins.

5/9/19-Thur.

Catch Basins-on the corner of Washington & York Rd. the basin needs rebuilt & poured. Should be a one-day job.

Berming-finish Wallings Rd. [between Ridge & State]. Start on the other half of Wallings Rd. [between State & the line].

Mowing-cut and weed whack around our guardrails.

5/10/19-Fri.

Asphalt-Y.M.C.A. grind out and install new asphalt in several areas. Also installed a strip in front of 11924 Abbey Rd.

Storm Water-Vac. out recent basin repairs in Hunters Creek and Glen Abbey.

5/13/19-Mon.

Storm Water-catch basins, start working on Chesapeake Dr. there are 15 basins that need rebuilt or tuck pointed.
Berming-continue on Wallings Rd. between State & the Broadview Heights line.
Mowing-continue cutting around our guardrails.

5/14/19-Tue.

Storm Water-catch basins, continue on Chesapeake Dr.
Berming-Wallings Rd. moving west from the line.
Mowing-continue cutting around our guardrails.

5/15/19-Wed.

Storm Water-Bennett & Rt82, jet out and vac the storm lines and the main box culvert going across the street.
Berming-continue on Wallings Rd.
Catch Basins-set up basins for a Thursday pour.

5/16/19-Thur.

Storm Water-Bennett & 82, pipes are separated in 3 areas. It's a 4ft section on Bennett Rd. that will be dug out and repaired.
Berming-Wallings Rd.
Catch Basins-poured 6 basins on Chesapeake Dr.

5/17/19-Fri.

Asphalt-3271 Akins Rd. installed an asphalt strip [new driveway]. Then sent the same crew to Wallings Rd. for berming in the afternoon.
Concrete-saw cut Pioneer Tr. For future joint repairs.

5/20/19-Mon.

Berming-finish Wallings Rd.
Storm Water-catch basins, start work on the other side of Chesapeake Dr.

5/21/19-Tue.

Storm Water-catch basins, continue working on Chesapeake Dr.
Culvert Pipe Replacement-11898 Albion Rd. remove & replace pipe and set up for a Wednesday pour.

5/22/19-Wed.

Storm Water-catch basins, pour 4 basins & half of slab on Chesapeake Dr.
Culvert Pipe- pour the new apron at 11898 Albion Rd. In the afternoon Crack Sealed.

5/23/19-Thur.

Storm Water-catch basins, pour 3 basins & half of slab on Chesapeake Dr.
Culvert Pipe Replacement-7134 Wallings Rd. remove & replace and install concrete apron.

5/24/19-Fri.

Storm Water-continue working on Chesapeake Dr.
Asphalt-install strips in our recent apron jobs. We will also pull forms & landscape everything.
Vac. Truck-Jet & Vac. basins in Hunters Creek.

5/28/19-Tue.

Storm Water-clean out trough in the Lodge retention basin.
Catch Basins-Chesapeake Dr.
Vac. Truck-finish up in Hunters Creek, then move to Cedar Estates.
Saw Cutting-open up all of our recent basin pours. This is being done for future crack sealing.

5/29/19-Wed.

Catch Basins-Chesapeake Dr. set up for Thursday pour.

Storm Water-12438 Albion Rd. remove old pipe in the front of their property, [rusted & collapsed].

Vac. Truck-Bennett Rd. We did both sides, from Rt82 to the bottom of the hill.

5/30/19-Thur.

Catch Basins-poured 5 basins and half of slab on Chesapeake Dr. This completes our basin repair project. We will crack seal the entire development Friday.

Storm Water-We ditched out 15965 State Rd. & 15039 State Rd. to improve water flow. Then went to 10313 York Rd. to restore the berm & ditch. This will get the water off the road and into the ditch.

5/31/19-Fri.

Crack Sealing- Chesapeake Development.

Concrete-Pioneer Trl. The cul-de-sac needs joint repaired.
