

**STREETS COMMITTEE MINUTES
MAY 1, 2018**

The Streets Committee meeting was held on May 1, 2018 at North Royalton City Hall, 14600 State Road. The meeting was called to order at 6:05 p.m.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Moved by Mr. Nickell, seconded by Mr. Antoskiewicz to **approve the April 3, 2018 Streets Committee minutes.** Roll Call: Yeas: 3. Nays: 0. **Motion carried.**

UNFINISHED BUSINESS

1. Issue 1 Funding

No update.

2. North Royalton Alternative Transportation Study

Mr. Schmitzer said that the sidewalk plans for State Road will be submitted this month to ODOT for their review. Once we get approval, ODOT will go out to bid for the construction of the sidewalk.

3. Service Department Report

Mr. Cinquepalmi reviewed the report, a copy of which is attached to these minutes. Mr. Langshaw commented on the York Road work being done and said that it is good to see the road program begin so early in the season. Mr. Cinquepalmi said that this has been the plan since last year. There are currently two different contractors working throughout the city. Mr. Nickell asked how much of York Road had been repaired. Mr. Cinquepalmi said they went from Rt. 82 all the way to Sprague Road. Mrs. Hannan asked if this winter was a bad winter for our streets. Mr. Cinquepalmi said we were hit very hard this winter and that is why they wanted to get to this work as early as possible.

4. 2016 Infrastructure Program

Mr. Schmitzer said that the warranty walk through will be scheduled for some time this month.

5. 2017 Infrastructure Program

Mr. Schmitzer said that the striping contractor came back and restriped the center line. He met with the Service Department and the contractor on Tilby Road regarding some erosion of the gravel berms west of Royal Haven as you go down the hill towards York Road. He said that they found that the water could not get off the road and into the ditches in some areas, so these areas were washed out. He said that the contractor will be coming out to pave about 1,400 to 1,500 lineal feet of these shoulders with asphalt so that this will not happen again. The contractor will contact him tomorrow with a date to perform this work. Mr. Nickell asked how we are going to remove the gravel from the ditches. Mr. Cinquepalmi said that this has already been done. They spent 2-3 days doing this work. He said that they are having to do less and less work after each storm because they are fixing the problems as they go along so it won't happen again. Mr. Nickell agreed that the complaints are less frequent.

NEW BUSINESS

1. 2018 Infrastructure Program

Mr. Antoskiewicz asked for an update on the 2018 road projects. Mr. Schmitzer said that the preconstruction meeting was held on Monday with Specialized Construction for South Akins. He said that the preconstruction meeting for Edgerton Road will be scheduled very shortly. He expects that both of these projects will be done back to back. He said that he gave them the Notice to Proceed on April 30th. This gives them 60 days to perform the work and the contractor had no concerns about getting the work

done for both roads in this timeframe, which will end on June 29th. It may be plus or minus a week or two. He said that this is the earliest he recalls ever getting the roads completed.

ADJOURNMENT

4/2/18-Mon.

Storm Water-12821 Drake Rd. finish repairs and backfill.

Patching-Edgerton Rd. then start on Oakwood Ln.

Catch Basins-St.Thomas Woods, pour concrete in the four basins we rebuilt last week.

4/3/18-Tue.

Storm Water-now that our work is completed on all the basins in St. Thomas Woods we will clean out all the catch basins and jet the laterals in St. Thomas Woods.

Catch Basins-start the basin repairs in the Planets.

Patching-Rt.82, Edgerton Rd., Boston Rd. and Ridge Rd.

4/4/18-Wed.

Storm Water Catch Basins-continue work in the planets.

Patching-Sprague Rd. Royal Valley and Helen Dr.

Vac. Truck-continue in St. Thomas Woods.

4/5/18-Thur.

Plowing- North of Rt82. Heavy snow for a few hours, spent the morning cleaning up.

14625 & 14607 State Rd. add stone to the Berm. Same crew went patching in the afternoon.

Storm Water Catch Basins-continue work in the Planets.

4/6/18-Fri.

Storm Water Catch Basins-finish setting up the 4 basins in the planets for an afternoon pour.

Patching.

Signs- deliver the H.H.W. to the county in the morning, Fix signs in the afternoon [per N.R.P.D.].

4/9/18-Mon.

Storm Water Catch Basins-Start another round of catch basins in the Planets; saw cut & hammer out [5 total].

Ditching-we need to ditch three different property's for future culvert replacements.

Patching.

4/10/18-Tue.

Storm Water Catch Basins-remove and replace 5 basins and set up for a Friday pour.

Landscaping-Spring clean up, fixing the sod by the curb on all the plow routes. We will go through every development in the city [we should be finished in a couple of weeks].

4/11/18-Wed.

Asphalt-Rt82.grind out long strips and fill with hot mix [the plant is temporally opened].

Storm Water Catch Basins-continue work in the Planets.

4/12/18-Thur.

Asphalt-continue work on Rt82.

Storm Water Catch Basins-continue work in the Planets.

4/13/18-Fri.

Asphalt-continue work on Rt82.

Storm Water Catch Basins-finish the rebuilds and pour the concrete in the afternoon.

4/16/18-Mon.

Storm Clean Up- Called in all the guys on Sunday night [heavy rains all day and into Monday morning].

4/17/18-Tue.

Salting-snow on and off all day.

Patching.

4/18/18-Wed.

Ditching-8767 Parkdale, Storm Water also needed to lower the catch basin for the water to flow properly.

Vac. Truck- jet & vac. basins and storm Lines on W. Hampton Dr.

4/19/18-Thur.

Ditching-on Tilby. Also on Cady Rd.

Patching-going into our developments to cold patch, [waiting for the asphalt plant to open].

4/20/18-Fri.

Asphalt-continue repairs on Rt.82

Storm Water Catch Basins-continue work in the Planets.

4/23/18-Mon.

Asphalt-3165 Sprague Rd. in the morning install the asphalt apron [from culvert replacement two weeks ago]. We had to wait for the Asphalt plant to open. In the afternoon we continue work on Rt. 82.

Storm Water Catch Basins-continue work in the Planets.

4/24/18-Tue.

Asphalt-continue work on Rt.82.

Storm Water Catch Basins-continue work in the Planets.

4/25/18-Wed.

Storm Water Catch Basins-set up 4 basins for concrete, we will pour them Thursday.

Asphalt-finish one side of Rt.82 to York Rd. We will start the west bound lane Thursday.

4/26/18-Thur.

Storm Water Catch Basins-pour new concrete around 4 basin repairs in the Planets.

Asphalt- Start west bound lane on Rt.82.

4/27/18-Fri.

Storm Water Catch Basins-start the last 4 basins in the planets.

Asphalt-finish Rt.82.

4/30/18-Mon.

Storm Water Catch Basins-continue work in the Planets.

Asphalt-grind & remove 6 to 8 bad spots in the Y.M.C.A. driveway. Filled with new asphalt.
