AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE BID OF WORKMAN INDUSTRIAL SERVICES, INC. FOR THE NORTH ROYALTON WASTEWATER TREATMENT PLANT A BELT FILTER PRESS REPLACEMENT PROJECT FOR AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$520,124.00 AS THE LOWEST AND BEST BID, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS: The City of North Royalton has advertised for bids for the North Royalton Wastewater Treatment Plant A Belt Filter Press Replacement Project; and

WHEREAS: It has been determined that the bid of Workman Industrial Services, Inc. for an amount not to exceed \$520,124.00 is the lowest and best bid; and

WHEREAS: Council desires to accept this bid.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH ROYALTON, COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA AND STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

Section 1. Council hereby accepts the bid of Workman Industrial Services, Inc.. for the North Royalton Wastewater Treatment Plant A Belt Filter Press Replacement Project for an amount not to exceed \$520,124.00 as the lowest and best bid as outlined in Exhibit A attached hereto and incorporated as if fully rewritten.

Section 2. The Mayor is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Workman Industrial Services, Inc. in a form approved by the Director of Law.

Section 3. The Wastewater Superintendent is hereby authorized and directed to forward a certified copy of this Ordinance to Workman Industrial Services, Inc. and all certified checks and bonds are hereby authorized to be returned to the unsuccessful bidders.

Section 4. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements.

Section 5. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the city, and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary to accept the bid of Workman Industrial Services, Inc. for the North Royalton Wastewater Treatment Plant A Belt Filter Press Replacement Project so that this work may commence.

The City of North Royalton received three (3) sealed bids for the above referenced project on March 8, 2017 which were opened and read publicly. A summary of the bids received, listed from apparent lowest to highest bid is as follows:

Workman Industrial Services, Inc.	\$520,124.00
North Bay Construction, Inc.	\$527,500.00
Cold Harbor Building Company	\$547,500.00

Based on the bid total amounts shown on the bid packages, the apparent low bidder was Workman Industrial Services, Inc. with a bid of \$520,124.00.

Brown and Caldwell evaluated the entire bid package for Workman Industrial Services, North Bay Construction, and Cold Harbor Building Company.

The Engineer's Estimate was \$600,000.00, which is approximately 13% higher than the average \$531,708.00 total bid amount of all the bids received. The total Bid amount offered by Workman Industrial Service is approximately 1% below the next lowest bid. The highest bid was approximately 9% lower than the Engineer's Estimate.

Based on our review of the bid packages that were submitted, Workman Industrial Services Bid (the apparent low bidder) generally conforms to the requirements stated in the Contract Documents. Workman Industrial Service has a current State Contractor's License and has been in business for over 32 years. Brown and Caldwell recommends awarding North Royalton Plant A Belt Filter Press Replacement Contract to Workman Industrial Services.
