#### **MAYOR'S REPORT:**

Mayor Stefanik updated Council on the grant application for Mr. and Mrs. Long on York Road. He said he got a hold of the Great Lakes Commission in Ann Arbor, Michigan and the representatives of the National Resources Conservation Services in Washington, D.C. He said that he got all of the parties on the phone last week and the grant was awarded. We should receive the money today or tomorrow through the Soil and Water Conservation District. He said that with these various organizations you have to light a fire under them to keep these projects moving. He said that he had threatened to visit the National Resources Conservation Services in person when he was in Washington D.C. last week with Congressman Renacci. He said the next step will be with the Army Corps of Engineers and the retention basin. He said they will be contacting our state and federal representatives to try and get this moving.

#### **PUBLIC DISCUSSION.**

**Eva Wronski**, 3249 Edgerton Road addressed Council in opposition of Ordinances 16-83 and 16-84. She asked that Council reassess this legislation after one year and look at the pros and cons and possibly consider repealing this legislation. Ms. Wronski showed photographs of a deer that had been killed by a coyote and said that the deer are not multiplying because the fawns are being killed by the growing coyote population. Mr. Antoskiewicz said that reviewing this legislation is part of the process. He said we will continue to see if this is working or not, or if it needs to be modified or tweaked. He said that this will be part of the ongoing process.
