NORTH ROYALTON RECOGNIZED CLUBS:

Baseball: Dr. John Kelly– Baseball registration is a little over 300 so far. About ½ the players are travel. Rec registrations are about 150 – 90% are residents – on par with last year. They sent out flyers to elementary schools. NRBB thanked Mayor Stefanik for putting registration information in city newsletter. They are planning on sending flyers for middle school too. NR HS may do something electronic. YMCA is going to offer t-ball for 3-4 year olds. Players 5 and older will be in the NRBB program. Players 22 and over will be in the YMCA program. NRBB will supply fields but NRBB and YMCA will split cost of prepping fields. The two varsity baseball coaches (boys and girls) will have manager clinics on sat March 12 at NRHS for NRBB baseball managers and coaches. They are also working on pitching clinics for boys and girls (fastpitch). Brad is working on doing something for the younger boys to teach correct pitching techniques at no charge. YMCA is still working on a Men's 35/55 and over league.

Soccer: Pete Ragone – They want NRBB to make sure that May 21-22 are blackout dates because of Soccer Days. They want to know if they can replace the logo on the Heasley Fields with the new logo. The city felt it should not be a problem to for NRSC to place a vinyl logo over top the old logo. They had to cancel the Ref clinic because only 3 people signed up. They thanked NR schools for use of gym. Spring games and footskills for the HS Stadium has been booked. Footskills are Friday nights. Spring registration is open. The girls and boys HS coaches are going to have a coach's clinic at the field house on March 19. The boys and girls travel program is going to enter the Medina tournament. The concussion laws are going to change (maybe as early as fall season) to have no heading for U10 and below. The field and goal sizes will be changing in the younger groups. Jason said they are closing Heasley field 3 for maintenance as soon as the weather improves. As of Feb 18, 2016 the NRSC is a 501c3 corporation. Pete is looking for community service projects for his HS Girls soccer team.
