1. **Oil and gas appeal update**

Mr. Kasaris thanked the Safety Director for the informative email on Ebola. He asked what the plan is for Cuyahoga County. Mr. Campbell said that he has been to several meetings recently and the county has not yet determined which hospital would be the one to handle the cases. He said that University Hospitals has stated that if we have a patient who meets this criteria, that we should transport them to the Case Western Campus. There are only a few hospitals that can actually perform the test to confirm the Ebola diagnosis. Mr. Campbell said that the City of Cleveland is still working with the city and county health departments and the CDC to come up with one county wide hospital and county wide protocol. They have a follow up meeting this Thursday. He stressed that there are no confirmed cases in the county at this time.
