NORTH ROYALTON RECOGNIZED CLUBS:

Baseball: Mike Kekic – Bear brawl was this past weekend. There were only 4 ejections for the tournament down from 8 last year's tournament. Put a sunscreen on right field at Memorial to cut sun glare and distractions people on bleachers in the outfield. NRBB's list of maintenance concerns sent to the city. There are now eight lights out at York 3. York 6 has issues with breakers blowing midway through the game. The hot water tank died at concession stand. Girls ASA tournament 10-12U will be July 4,5,6 will be at York Field.

Season Summary:

Our 2013 volleyball program was open to any North Royalton student who wants to play volleyball provided they filled out a waiver form and followed NRVclub polices. We had 14 boys attend at least one practice/game in 2013. Kevin Baran (SO) was selected to the second team regional all start team and Darren Allison (SR) received honorable mention. We have 5 juniors coming back next season that we can build a team around for the next two seasons.

The 2014 season was very challenging because the gym time schedule was unknown until 3/8/2014. This made it difficult to recruit players and schedule games at the OHSBVA coaches meeting. Being allowed to advertise in the high school and having open gyms in February and early March would help to grow this program. Our goal is to have a JV and Varsity teams for 2014 and 2015.




