

**UTILITIES COMMITTEE MINUTES
JUNE 3, 2014**

The Utilities Committee meeting was held on June 3, 2014 at North Royalton City Hall, 13834 Ridge Road. The meeting was called to order at 6:50 p.m.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

UNFINISHED BUSINESS

1. **Inflow/Infiltration of storm water**

Mayor Stefanik said that the Wastewater Department has been working on Valley Lane because they reported major sanitary flooding. He said that they found a lot of cracks in the piping and they are going to have to re-sleeve these lines. He said they will be heading next over to St. Thomas Woods where there have been issues going on since 1989 based on documents we were able to find. He said that they will smoke and dye test the area. He said he was out there two Saturdays ago with members of the Service Department. We pulled up the manhole covers and found storm water running through, grass, etc. so something is not right. We are going to go through every pipe in this development until we find out what it is. Mayor Stefanik said that Mr. Tigue suggested that we might have to rent larger pieces of equipment to check the sanitary line between Royalwood Road and the last back yard by Mr. Florio's home to see if there are any issue there. He said that he has read through all of the documents regarding the issues they have had and he said that everyone kept sweeping it under the rug, but he said we are going to address it once and for all for these residents. He said that there has been some talk about putting in another pump station and pumping it to a sanitary line in another area of the city. He said that they will continue working in this area and we have suspended the work being done in Sewer District B for now.

2. **A-Plant Permit**

Mayor Stefanik reported that the permit was received last week. There is a 30 day period where it is put out statewide for comments.
