

**STREETS COMMITTEE MINUTES
JANUARY 2, 2019**

The Streets Committee meeting was held on January 2, 2019 at North Royalton City Hall, 14600 State Road. The meeting was called to order at 6:16 p.m.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

UNFINISHED BUSINESS

1. Issue 1 Funding

Mayor Stefanik said there is a meeting next week where they will officially accept the scoring that was provided to them by the Issue 1 Committee. It looks like we are not going to get funding for Abbey Road but the widening of Sprague Road between York and W. 130th did receive funding. He said that this was \$4 million+ and this will help us out regarding what our cost share might be on this project. Mayor Stefanik said that we still have the application in at the county for the yearly program where they put in up to \$250,000 towards a project. He said that we put in Albion and Abbey for this funding. Mr. Langshaw asked when we would know about Albion and Abbey. Mayor Stefanik felt it would be soon.

2. North Royalton Alternative Transportation Study

3. Service Department Report

Mr. Cinquepalmi said that due to the mild weather and two shifts, they have been able to do a lot of building maintenance that there is usually not a lot of time for. He said the snow equipment is ready, the labor is ready and the salt barn is full in anticipation of future snow fall. Mr. Antoskiewicz asked if we sustained any damage due to the recent heavy winds. Mr. Cinquepalmi said that in anticipation of the rain they checked all of the pinch points and reviewed the flood list with both shifts. He said there was very minor wind damage and a few power outages, but did not turn out to be as bad as expected. Mr. Marnecheck asked if the weather stays nice, what is the likelihood that the asphalt plants will open. He said that they would only open for large companies doing large projects and they won't even gamble on doing that unless they know that they have nice enough weather to bring all their laborers back. He said that they will most likely not open until spring.

4. 2016 Infrastructure Program

Mr. Schmitzer said that this program is all closed out and the warranty is done. **Remove from agenda.**

5. 2017 Infrastructure Program

Mr. Schmitzer said that we have one year remaining on the warranty work for Royalhaven, Parkdale and Tilby. There are still some small areas that we want to look at again regarding berm work. Specialized Construction has committed to getting this done in the spring or sooner, weather permitting.

6. 2018 Infrastructure Program

Mr. Schmitzer said that just about everything is done. Edgerton Road is completely done and the punch list has been approved and we have a two year warranty on this. South Akins Road still has one small area with some drainage issues. The contractor will be back for the latter half of the 2018 program this spring so we will be looking at it then. He said that for the most part this road is done. He said that we had substantial savings on both of these roads close to the six figure range. The other roads, along with the Police Station and Wastewater Treatment plant are just about done. The Police Station and the Wastewater Treatment plant work is completely finished. The Sprague Road overlay with Parma is completely done. The other 5 roads are done except for the work that we agreed would be done in the spring which is the chip and fog seal and the one inch leveling coarse on Gabriella, Delsy and Akins.

MISCELLANEOUS

Mr. Nickell asked for an update on First Energy putting in a sidewalk on Ridge Road. Mayor Stefanik said that we have to get them a price for this coming year. He said that we will get this once we go out to bid for next years stone, concrete, etc. He said that we are going to install the sidewalk and they are going to reimburse us.
