

STORM WATER COMMITTEE MINUTES JANUARY 2, 2019

The Storm Water Committee meeting was held on January 2, 2019 at North Royalton City Hall, 14600 State Road. The meeting was called to order at 6:02 p.m.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

UNFINISHED BUSINESS

1. Storm Water/Infrastructure Maintenance Monthly Report

Mr. Cinquepalmi said they have been working on culvert clean outs.

2. Maintenance Projects

Mr. Cinquepalmi said that they wrapped up the patching before the end of the season. Mr. Schmitzer said that they received pricing for 4 storm repairs that were a little deeper than what we could handle on Julia Drive, Drake Road, Albion Road and Bunker Road. DiGioia Suburban performed this work. He said that final restorations will be made in the spring. Mr. Nickell asked if the work on Albion was at the intersection of Albion and Abbey. Mr. Schmitzer said that work was done by our Service Department. This work was further down where the Biro Ditch cuts across. There was a disconnect in the pipe that needed to be repaired. Mr. Marnecheck asked if video was taken of the driveway aprons before the work began. Mr. Schmitzer said yes, the driveway on the south side is completely cracked and broken off. DiGioia is aware of this and will repair it in the spring. Mr. Langshaw asked what the problem was at Albion and Abbey. Mr. Cinquepalmi said that there is a 12 inch main that runs underneath going west to east. We know that this pipe needs to be replaced but because of the traffic we kept postponing it until we could sub it out, but it couldn't wait so we fixed the pipe at the outlet and extended the pipe in the ditch about 15 feet. He said that it is safe for now and next year we are going to address this further.

3. Turnpike Mitigation

Mr. Schmitzer said that the final plan submittal for the York Road drainage improvement will be Friday. He said that ODOT will review these plans and once he knows the schedule he will share this with Council. Mr. Antoskiewicz asked if this work will go across Rt. 82 as well, or will it be just in front of the ball fields. Mr. Schmitzer said that based on the limitations of the project, it has to be done on property owned by the city and/or the public right of way. He said it is between the east side of York Road and the Ohio Turnpike. It involves the large culvert that comes across and we are working on the channel from the bottom of the slope, across the driveway we have, all the way to the east side of York Road where we replaced the culvert a few years ago.

MISCELLANEOUS

Mr. Nickell said he wanted to let Mr. Schmitzer know that there was a large root ball on Elmwood Oval where the creek crosses Cedarwood. He felt that it might cause a storm water problem and asked him to look into it.
