

**UTILITIES COMMITTEE MINUTES  
NOVEMBER 5, 2014**

The Utilities Committee meeting was held on November 5, 2014 at North Royalton City Hall, 13834 Ridge Road. The meeting was called to order at 6:00 p.m.

**APPROVAL OF MINUTES**

**UNFINISHED BUSINESS**

**1. Inflow/Infiltration of storm water**

Mr. Tigue said that we have shut down dye testing for the season and will start up again in late April or early May. Mr. Tigue asked if there were any questions regarding the article about St. Thomas Woods. Mr. Antoskiewicz asked for the current status. Mr. Tigue said that we are finished with the testing. Some of the homes have already received their 60 day notices. We start with the 90 day notices, but some homes are in the 60 day period already. Out of the 31 that failed about one third have already made the necessary repairs. He said that they will be going into the woods with a rented machine small enough to get through our easement in order to jet the line between the Padua east cul-de-sac and 5629 Royalwood. The main sewer runs through this back yard. We will try to jet this main line to make sure that it is clear. Mr. Antoskiewicz asked if the 31 homes were in one concentrated area or was it mixed. Mr. Tigue said that most were on Padua east. There were about 11 that failed there. This is also where most of the flooding was. They are the end of the line for the development before it goes to the cul-de-sac and down to Royalwood. Padua north had about 5 fails, Hilary west had about 5, Hilary south had 4 and Bellarmine Drive had 2 for a total of 31 out of the 70+ homes in the subdivision. He said there are three manholes in the woods, so we will jet from one to the other and will inform the homeowners prior to our going onto their properties. We have an easement allowing access and we will obviously try to do no damage. Mr. Kasaris asked how much the machine rental would be. Mr. Tigue said \$400/day and we should only need it for one day. He said that he may consider purchasing a vehicle of this type in the future. We have a lot of easements so it would be useful to have this since we cannot get our big jet back there.
