PURPOSE: Public Discussion on Chippewa Creek Headland Park Grant funding available through the Clean Ohio Trails Fund

Presentation by Tom Jordan, North Royalton Economic Development Director

The intent of the grant application to the State of Ohio Department of Natural Resources is to obtain funding to create trails and promote a healthier lifestyle in the state of Ohio and to create linkages between city parks, state parks and federal parks or the regional parks such as the Cuyahoga County Metroparks.

Tom explained the application process of the Clean Ohio Fund which will be funded in 2012.

The specific proposal: we are proposing using the parking lots associated with YMCA and the Cuyahoga Public Library facilities and their sidewalks to link a small trail head for a walk way path to a sheltered area with an open air interpretive center.

The cost will be approximately \$150,000 of state money and \$37,000 match from the city of North Royalton, it is a 80/20 program. It has been reviewed for a historical impact of the area and environmental impact.
