

UTILITIES COMMITTEE MINUTES
APRIL 7, 2015

The Utilities Committee meeting was held on April 7, 2015 at North Royalton City Hall, 14600 State Road. The meeting was called to order at 6:03 p.m.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Moved by Mr. Kasaris, seconded by Mr. Langshaw to **approve the March 3, 2015 minutes.** Yeas: 3. Nays: 0.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS

1. Inflow/Infiltration of storm water.

Mr. Tigue said that they expect to begin dye testing the week of April 20, 2015. He said that due to the summer vacation schedule we are going to put the main streets ahead of Pamela Drive at this point. We need 3 people to do a main street and only 2 for side streets, so we will have more resources in April and May than we will in June, July and August. We are going to do Ridge Road first, and then move to Sprague Road or York Road. We will then pick up Pamela Drive later in the season. Mr. Kasaris asked where they will go next once the work in Ward 1 is finished. Mr. Tigue said that he and Mr. Shantery will be putting together a plan and present it to the Mayor. He said that he would like to look at lift station and development areas because during heavy rains there is some sanitary sewer overflow which means that the lift stations in the developments have too much I&I. We have to report these overflows to the Ohio EPA. If we are going to have to report that we have an issue, he would rather concentrate on developments that have created these overflows. Mr. Kasaris asked if this included Nottingham. Mr. Tigue said that Nottingham is one of them. Pine Stream, Hunters Creek and Devonshire are some of the others. He said that he wants to prioritize these and submit the plan to the Mayor. He said that most of the lift stations are in A District. Mr. Kasaris asked how many lift stations we have city wide. Mr. Tigue said that there are eleven.
