Legal

Donna Vozar: New Concussion law. April 26th the new law will go into effect. The city wants to make sure the organizations are in compliance. Organizations may want to have parents sign that they receive form. Each organization must decide how they are going to comply. They need to consult their legal counsel. The City will require a letter certifying that all coaches have completed training prior to 4/26th. They also need verification that all parents have provided the department of health concussion information sheet.

Baseball: Mike Kekic – Working to comply with Concussion law. Registration 560 boys (720 2012), girls 410 (560 in 2012). They are having a late registration 4/7/12 trying to get numbers up. They working on fixing broken 24hr lights at field to help prevent people from falling on paths. Talking to a security company about surveillance cameras to help with Break-ins at field. Repaired backstop #2.

Soccer: Pete Ragone – Registrations are done - 77 players. They had to add another u8 team. 293 travel players. Pictures were last Saturday. Game schedules have sent to Larry B. so fields can be ready

Single card – looking into the idea of forming a club of travel teams from surrounding cities. They then could create a premier team (tournament team) picked from member teams. Maybe call it “Cuyahoga Valley Soccer Academy”.
