

**SAFETY COMMITTEE MINUTES
APRIL 17, 2018**

The Safety Committee meeting was held on April 17, 2018, at North Royalton City Hall, 14600 State Road. The meeting was called to order at 6:00 p.m.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

NEW BUSINESS

1. Purchase of squad – Fire Department

Chief Chegan said that this will be the first of two squads they will purchase in the next two years. He said that they will be rotating out a 2003 ambulance. This will be the same type of ambulance we have purchased in the past. Mr. Langshaw asked how long it will take before we receive the vehicle. Chief Chegan said that we are probably looking at the beginning of next year. He said that the vehicle we plan to purchase next year will be less expensive since we will be able to transfer the power cot from the vehicle that we will rotate out at that time. This equipment is not available in the 2003 ambulance for transfer and we therefore have to purchase the power cot. Mr. Nickell asked for the model years of the rest of the fleet. Chief Chegan said that the second oldest is a 2009, and the two front line vehicles are 2011, both of which are approaching 100,000 miles. Mr. Nickell asked how many runs each ambulance do in a year. Chief Chegan said that since they go out on fire calls as well, he felt that it would be close to 2,000 each per year.

Moved by Mr. Langshaw, seconded by Mr. Petrusky to **recommend approval of Ordinance 18-48 to Council**. Roll Call: Yeas: 3. Nays: 0. **Motion carried.**

2. Receipt of a BWC Grant – Fire Department

Chief Chegan said that we were awarded over \$10,000. Our match is \$2,000 and we have already budgeted this money. This will be for the purchase of replacement personal protective equipment.

Moved by Mr. Langshaw, seconded by Mr. Petrusky to **recommend approval of Ordinance 18-47 to Council**. Roll Call: Yeas: 3. Nays: 0. **Motion carried.**
