## REPORTS

### Recreation Department

**Jason Swim** – The City has started the repair work on Heasley Field1. They are also fixing the Heasley parking lot Asphalt. There was discussion about moving dumpster, so the garbage trucks will not have to turn around, which is tearing up the asphalt.

They are adding material to the walkway from parking lot to York 6&7. They installed a new sign on Akins road at the entrance to York 8, saying “York 8 Ball field Parking”. Jason said they could not find a problem with the fencing near a culvert near as reported. It was discussed that the problem was incorrectly reported and may be near York 1.

### School Board

**Larry Antoskiewicz** – Playground is well on its way. They are reviewing bids for new asphalt from parking lot to Soccer fields at Memorial Park and to fix upper pavilion. Still hoping playground will be ready to open on Memorial Day.

They have found a volunteer to run the concession stand, her name is Erin Saunders. Mr. Ragone asked Mr. Swim about installing orange construction fence on the North side of Heasley Field 3 to prevent balls from rolling off the field. NRSC is willing to purchase the material.
