

## **STREETS COMMITTEE MINUTES**

### **MARCH 7, 2017**

### **UNFINISHED BUSINESS**

1. **Issue 1 Funding**

No update.

2. **North Royalton Alternative Transportation Study**

Mayor Stefanik said that a meeting is scheduled with NOACA this Friday and there is a chance that we may get the results from our latest submission for sidewalks from City Hall north to Rt. 82.

3. **Service Department Report**

A copy of the report is attached to these minutes. Mrs. Hannan thanked Mr. Cinquepalmi for addressing the issue in Ward 5 with the fallen tree. Mr. Langshaw thanked Mr. Cinquepalmi for providing the monthly recycling numbers. Regarding these numbers, Mr. Petrusky asked for an explanation of what REC-RO stands for, as well as MSW-RO. Mr. Cinquepalmi said that REC-RO stands for Recycle Roll Off. This is the roll off container we have at the Service Department Yard. MSW-RO stands for Municipal Solid Waste Roll Off. These are the two 40 yard dumpsters where residents bring rubbish and scrap steel. Mr. Nickell said that a resident on Glen Willow called about a chuck hole that was filled once and is now in need of filling again and asked that the Service Department take a look at this. Mr. Cinquepalmi said that they would go back and cold patch and once the asphalt plants open they will provide a more permanent solution.

4. **2016 Infrastructure Program**

Mayor Stefanik said that we will more than likely only be doing Tilby Road this year due to funding. He said that we will be utilizing the bid from Crossroads Asphalt to do joint repairs in subdivisions. He said that the engineering work and bid advertising for Tilby Road will be done sooner than in the past so we can get this project started. Mr. Kasaris asked how we do joint repairs so our streets don't end up looking like York Road in Parma. Mr. Cinquepalmi said that the best way is to do what Crossroads will be doing. They have a planer and will plane 6 inches right off the top whether it is concrete or asphalt. This way the road will not fracture like it would if we used a jack hammer. After they plane it they will seal it and fill it with hot asphalt. This is the best way to do this type of work. Mayor Stefanik said that we will be evaluating the locations for the joint repairs after winter and see where it is the worst and start there first.

### **NEW BUSINESS**

1. **Purchase of two (2) Tandem Axle Dump Bodies for the Service Department**

Mr. Cinquepalmi said that these are for the two trucks that we ordered last month. The trucks are being built and we need to outfit these trucks when they are received. We do not need to order salt spreaders since we can reuse the stainless steel ones we currently have. The trucks are expected to be delivered in 5-6 weeks and we will then send them to the body company and that usually takes 4-5 months. These vehicles will then be ready for next winter.

Salting-All Shifts.

Garage-Move salt from the compost bldg. to our salt barn.

2/3/17-FRI.

Patching-checking all roads, both shifts.

Garage-continue to move salt.

2/6/17-MON.

Patching-York Rd., Albion Rd, and Edgerton Rd.

Compost Building-Cleaned the building after running the last few loads of salt; the salt barn is full again.

2/7/17-TUES.

Storm Basin Maintenance-sent all the crews out to clean storm structures [heavy rains over night & in the morning].

2/8/17-WEDS.

Patching-cold patching all the mains.

2/9/17-THUR.

Snow Plowing- All Shifts.

2/10/17-FRI.

Patching-finish our mains and secondary's.

Salting-light snow late in the day.

2/13/17-MON.

Patching-Rt.82, Ridge Rd. also check and patch any potholes in our developments.

Signs-fix traffic lights per N.R.P.D. also replace the stop sign at Stoneycreek and Rustic.

2/14/17-TUES.

Patching-Continue working in our developments [northeast corner].

2/15/17-WEDS.

Signs-replaced traffic lights, also took the H.H.W. down to the C.C.S.W.D.

Patching- Moved to the central developments.

2/16/17-THUR.

Plowing-All Shifts.

2/17/17-FRI.

Storm Water-ditching 18514 Ridge Rd, 12150 Albion Rd and 12485 Sprague Rd.  
Patching-Akins Rd. Edgerton Rd. and York Rd.

2/20/17-MON.

Patching-Start patching the developments in the northwest section of the city. Second shift will start working on the developments in the southwest section of the city.

2/21/17-TUES.

Storm Water-hydro-excavate the storm line at the corner of Akins & Ridge, once open I split the crew up, two stayed to repair the line. The rest of the crew went to jet out culvert pipes on Albion Rd.

2/22/17-WEDS.

Storm Water-Jet and clean the storm line under Akins Rd. by Ridge Rd., this is the line we repaired Tuesday. [Stone & debris filled up the line before repairs could be made]. Also we checked the storm line at 3691 Royalwood Rd.

Storm Water-3691 Royalwood Rd. repaired the storm line and backfilled the sinkhole & landscaped.

2/24/17-FRI.

Street Sweeping-finish Sharon Dr. and did all of Hunters Creek.

Patching-Sharon Dr., North Akins Rd., Rt82. Maple La. and Hunters Creek.

Signs-reattached the mirror to the pole at the top of Cady hill. Fixed a mailbox on W130.

2/27/17-MON.

Storm Water-Jet out two culvert pipes on Abbey Rd. Also jetted out and ran the camera through the culvert pipes [the front yard is piped in] at 19761 State Rd.

Berming-Rt82 we started putting 304 stone in the berm north of Ashlee Woods [the berm has sunk in front of most of the mailboxes].

2/28/17-TUES.

Storm Basin Maintenance-sent all the crews out to check and clean our storm structures [heavy rains in the forecast].

Street Sweeper-sent the sweeper to Oakridge development and Royal Valley development.
