

**STORM WATER COMMITTEE MINUTES
FEBRUARY 7, 2017**

The Storm Water Committee meeting was held on February 7, 2017 at North Royalton City Hall, 14600 State Road. The meeting was called to order at 6:02 p.m.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

2. 2017 Projects

Mr. Schmitzer reported that the Cedar Estates basin is in for review at both the Sewer District and Soil & Water. He said that he expects approvals within the next two weeks. At that point they will have the bid package ready, accept the bids and start construction within the first week or two of March. He said that the project will take 6 months. Mr. Nickell expressed his displeasure with the bureaucratic system that the city is forced to follow for a project like this but is glad to hear that this project is moving forward.

3. Turnpike Mitigation

Mr. Schmitzer said that there is no update on the sound wall project. A revised schedule for the drainage improvement project by our ball fields on York Road will be submitted within 2 weeks to ODOT for their review. Once it is approved, it will be bid out and managed by ODOT from that point on. When we originally applied for the permit, we applied for various ditching projects adjacent to the turnpike and to our ball fields. Since then the turnpike has done some improvements where they have actually done some of the ditching that we had anticipated doing. He said that we may still do a portion near York Road by the ball field driveway just south of Rt. 82.

NEW BUSINESS

1. Ordinances 17-10, 17-16, 17-17.

Mr. Antoskiewicz asked Mr. Schmitzer for a brief explanation of Ordinances 17-16 and 17-17. Mr. Schmitzer said that these are projects that have already been performed by the Sewer District from the May 2014 floods as a part of the OEMA money we received. This legislation simply cleans up the final numbers and costs for these projects. Mr. Kasaris said that one ordinance is actually reducing the original cost of one of the projects.

Regarding Ordinance 17-10, Mr. Schmitzer said that the sewer district has partnered together with the Board of Health and Soil and Water to do some of these services at no cost which used to cost the city money on an annual basis.
