

STREETS COMMITTEE MINUTES
JUNE 3, 2014

The Streets Committee meeting was held on June 3, 2014 at North Royalton City Hall, 13834 Ridge Road. The meeting was called to order at 6:54 p.m.

(Service Director Nick Cinquepalmi, Wastewater Superintendent Tim Tigue, City Engineer Mark Schmitzer, Service Supervisor John Fielding, and Storm Water Supervisor Mike Lung were present this evening, but meeting with residents one on one at this time).

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Moved by Mr. Antoskiewicz, seconded by Mr. Nickell to **approve the May 6, 2014 minutes.** Yeas: 3. Nays: 0. **Motion carried.**

UNFINISHED BUSINESS

1. **2014 Road Program**

Mayor Stefanik reported that the Wiltshire Road program will start Monday and is expected to take 30-45 days to complete. He said that on Council's agenda for approval this evening is the legislation for the Julia Drive, et.al. project. He said that pending approval, the preconstruction meeting is scheduled for June 10th. The preconstruction meeting for Pebble Brooke is scheduled for tomorrow. Mayor Stefanik said that crack sealing and concrete work has been halted temporarily due to the storm work that needed to be performed. He said that they might consider subbing out the two cul-de-sacs at Bunker and Greenwood Oval because we are unsure if we will be able to get to it in-house this year.

2. **Sprague Road**

Mayor Stefanik said that we will be going out to bid at the end of July or beginning of August. The other municipal engineers are still reviewing the plans. There are some failed pipes under the Parma side of the road that need to be addressed either in this project or on their own before the road is repaired. Mr. Petrusky asked if there is work planned near Thornhurst where the other creek floods. Mayor Stefanik said that we are working on this with Parma.

3. **Issue 1 Funding**

Mayor Stefanik said that the criteria for these projects is still being reviewed. Once this criteria is determined, this will guide us as to what projects we will be submitting later on this year. He said that the time line is pushed back again this year so there is more time to apply.

4. **City Sidewalks**

Mayor Stefanik asked Mr. Jordan for an update on the NOACA sidewalk issue. Mr. Jordan said we will have our first meeting with the group from ODOT, the county and NOACA sometime this month to get all the mapping information together. He said that ODOT will bring their plans for their state routes, and the county will bring plans for the county roads. He said in addition to monthly meetings with these organizations, there will be two community meetings at the start and at the finish of the study. The first will allow for the public to state what they feel is necessary in alternative transportation modes and the second will be a presentation to the public of the study's findings. He anticipated the first public meeting will be held sometime in September. Mayor Stefanik asked if these meetings will be held during the day or in the evening. Mr. Jordan said it will be held during the day. Mayor Stefanik asked Mr. Jordan to let Council know when this meeting is being held so that arrangements can be made to attend.
