Recreation Department

Jason Swim – Met with Mr. Kekic (NRBB) about safety issues with fences. The City fixed safety issues identified with fence going to York 8 and is looking at addressing other issues. Heasley field 1 is coming in nicely, but the rain is causing issues with trying to fix other fields.

School Board

Dr. John Kelly – Grass is being installed in infield on HS1. The district is not paying for it – all from donations. Two track athletes went to state finished 5th in long jump and Christine won pole vault and set to state record.

Council

Paul Marnecheck – All quiet, nothing to report.

Mayor

Robert Stefanik – The fountain at Memorial park is working. Playground is complete and getting a lot of use. The restroom renovation at Memorial Park is also complete. Mayor said that only a few people have asked for their bricks from the old playground. The city is giving them back as people ask. The Community Festival is on City green this year after the parade. The city has received a lot of compliments on new playground.

Dr. Kelly will talk to school board to make sure the cost is correct. It was suggested that volleyball do a fundraiser to earn the money.


