NORTH ROYALTON RECOGNIZED CLUBS:

Baseball: Terry Veverka – Light outages on 4 & 8, city fixed them. St. Albert South had grass in the infield. Baseball registration down 11 teams this year.

Soccer: Pete Ragone – Soccer days went well. They were able to make up 1 of the 3 cancelled weeks. Only a few folks were upset. NRSC gave City the check for the city fees. Still have 3 more weeks of travel games left. Soccer is done with field 3 – city can start working on field for next season. Everything that is left can be done on 1 and 2. They are going to have girls youth camp 7/30-7/31 at Heasley and 8/1 at stadium 5-8.

Basketball: Tom Grassi – Not in attendance.

Volleyball: Bob Baran – Season is over. They played 9 games, won 1 game a playoff game. 9 total people 4 seniors and 4 sophomores. They are hopeful for next year.

NEW BUSINESS

Mr. Santangelo inquired about the city having summer concerts like Broadview Heights and Brecksville. He suggested that the city could partner with them and solicit corporate sponsors.

OLD BUSINESS

Playground – Tom Jordan & Jeff Snider - Playground will be relocated further downhill. Snider and associates was awarded state contract. State bid pricing better than grant flyer. The new playground will be ADA compliant. There was discussion about which of the 3 possible groundcovers should be used. The poured rubber would last the longest, but it was also the most expensive to install. The rubber mulch was also more expensive than just using plain wood mulch. It was determined both the wood and rubber mulch would need to be replenished each year. The rubber mulch was also dirty and some parents do not like it. Mr. Santangelo moved that the city chose the Mulch option, so that they could get more playground equipment for the budget. Motion was seconded by Mr. Wells. Motion passed.




ADJOURNMENT



