RESOLUTION NO. 13-14

A RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE CERTIFICATION OF THE COUNTY FISCAL OFFICER
PURSUANT TO SECTION 5705.03 OF THE REVISED CODE, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS: It is necessary for Council to request the Cuyahoga County Fiscal Officer to certify, in accordance with Section 5705.03 of the Revised Code, the total current tax valuation of the City of North Royalton and the dollar amount of revenue that would be generated by a 1.7 mill renewal of a levy for the purpose of providing emergency medical service which expires with the levy made on the 2012 tax list and duplicate, to be collected in 2013.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH ROYALTON, COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA AND STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

Section 1. This Council hereby requests the Cuyahoga County Fiscal Officer to certify, in accordance with Section 5705.03 of the Revised Code, the total current tax valuation of the City of North Royalton and the dollar amount of revenue that would be generated by a 1.7 mill renewal of a levy for the purpose of providing emergency medical service which expires with the levy made on the 2012 tax list and duplicate, to be collected in 2013. The question of the renewal of the 1.7 mill levy for the purpose of providing emergency medical service would be for a period of five years, beginning with the tax list and duplicate for the year 2013, to be first distributed to this City in calendar year 2014 and would be placed on the ballot for the May 7, 2013 election.

Section 2. The Director of Legislative Services, in her capacity as Clerk of Council, is hereby directed to certify a copy of this Resolution to the Cuyahoga County Fiscal Officer immediately upon its adoption.

Section 3. This Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with the law.

Section 4. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the City, and for the further reason that this Resolution is required to be immediately effective so that it can be timely filed with the Cuyahoga County Fiscal Officer to obtain the certifications necessary to be able to timely submit the question of the tax levy at the election described herein.

THEREFORE, provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Mayor, otherwise, from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
