ORDINANCE NO. 13-76

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 12-195 WHICH AUTHORIZED THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH THE INTERNATIONAL ASSOCIATION OF FIRE FIGHTERS, AFL-CIO LOCAL 2156, BY AMENDING EXHIBIT A, ARTICLE XXXIII INSURANCE, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS: Council and the Administration have conducted negotiations with the International Association of Fire Fighters, AFL-CIO, Local 2156 as the bargaining representative for certain members of the Fire Department; and

WHEREAS: Such negotiations have provided a tentative agreement between the parties and was adopted under Ordinance 12-195; and

WHEREAS: It is necessary to amend Article XXXIII of this agreement in order to provide amended insurance benefits as agreed to by the bargaining unit; and

WHEREAS: Council and the Administration desire to provide for this amendment.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH ROYALTON, COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA AND STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

Section 1. Ordinance 12-195 which authorized the Mayor to enter into a contract with the International Association of Fire Fighters, AFL-CIO Local 2156, Exhibit A, Article XXXIII Insurance, is hereby amended as provided for in Exhibit A attached hereto and incorporated as if fully rewritten.

Section 2. Any and all ordinances in conflict with the express provisions of this Agreement are superseded by this Agreement.

Section 3. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were passed in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such actions were in meetings open to the public and in compliance with all legal requirements.

Section 4. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the city, and for the further reason that is immediately necessary to provide for this amendment.

THEREFORE, provided this Ordinance receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
