

# THE CITY COUNCIL OF NORTH ROYALTON, OHIO

ORDINANCE NO. 13-139

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE PROPOSAL OF AETNA TO PROVIDE A COMPREHENSIVE GROUP MEDICAL HEALTH CARE BENEFIT PLAN FOR ALL ELIGIBLE EMPLOYEES OF THE CITY, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS: Council desires to obtain a comprehensive group medical health care benefit plan for all eligible employees of the city and has sought proposals for this purpose; and

WHEREAS: Council finds that the proposal of Aetna to provide a comprehensive group medical health care benefit plan to be the best proposal; and

WHEREAS: Council desires to accept this proposal.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH ROYALTON, COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA AND STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

Section 1. The Council of the City of North Royalton has determined that the proposal of Aetna to provide comprehensive group medical health care benefits for all eligible employees of the city in the amounts fully described in Exhibit A, attached hereto and incorporated herein, is the best proposal for said benefits.

Section 2. The City of North Royalton hereby accepts the proposal of Aetna to provide comprehensive group medical health care benefits for all eligible employees of the city for the period commencing January 1, 2014, and ending December 31, 2014, and the Mayor is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Aetna for said medical health care benefits consistent with the terms set forth in their proposal marked Exhibit A attached hereto and as more fully described in the contract which shall be substantially similar to Exhibit A and additional terms as approved by the Director of Law.

Section 3. The Director of Legislative Services is hereby directed to forward a certified copy of this Ordinance to Fedeli Group and Aetna confirming the acceptance of this proposal.

Section 4. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements.

Section 5. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the city, and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary to provide a comprehensive group medical health care benefit plan for all eligible employees of the city.

THEREFORE, provided this Ordinance receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
