AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND/OR THE DIRECTOR OF COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT TO REQUEST FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE UNDER THE RECREATIONAL TRAILS PROGRAM (RTP) AND/OR THE CLEAN OHIO TRAILS FUND (COTF), AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

- WHEREAS: The State of Ohio, through the Ohio Department of Natural Resources, administers financial assistance for public recreation purposes, through the Recreational Trails Program and/or the Clean Ohio Trails Fund; and
- WHEREAS: The City of North Royalton desires financial assistance under the Recreational Trails Program and/or the Clean Ohio Trails Fund; and
- WHEREAS: Council wishes to authorize the Mayor and/or the Director of Community Development to request this financial assistance.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH ROYALTON, COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA AND STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

Section 1. The Council of the City of North Royalton hereby approves the filing of an application for the Recreational Trails Program and/or the Clean Ohio Trails Fund financial assistance.

Section 2. The Mayor and/or the Director of Community Development are hereby authorized and directed to execute and file an application with the Ohio Department of Natural Resources and to provide all information and documentation required to become eligible for possible funding assistance.

Section 3. The City of North Royalton does agree to obligate the funds required to satisfactorily complete the proposed project and become eligible for reimbursement under the terms and conditions of the Recreational Trails Program and/or the Clean Ohio Trails Fund.

Section 4. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements.

Section 5. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the city, and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary to authorize and direct the Mayor and/or the Director of Community Development to execute and file an application with the Ohio Department of Natural Resources in order to seek financial assistance under the Recreational Trails Program and/or the Clean Ohio Trails Fund.

THEREFORE, provided this Ordinance receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
