A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING THE NORTH ROYALTON CITY SCHOOL DISTRICT'S \$49.8 MILLION BOND ISSUE

WHEREAS: The North Royalton City School District has a tradition of excellence in educating the children of the city; and

WHEREAS: A quality school district is essential to the quality of life and making the city a desirable place to live and raise a family; and

WHEREAS: The North Royalton City School District has a \$49.8 million Bond Issue before the voters of the District at an election to be held on May 6, 2014; and

WHEREAS: This Bond Issue will be used for a multitude of facility, safety and educational issues that need to be addressed at all buildings along with the renovation of the elementary buildings for the return of kindergarten and preschool back to their home schools; and

WHEREAS: The Council and Mayor Stefanik support the \$49.8 million Bond Issue and encourage all residents of the City of North Royalton to vote "Yes" on May 6, 2014.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH ROYALTON, COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA AND STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

Section 1. The Council of the City of North Royalton and Mayor Stefanik hereby declare their support for the North Royalton City School District's \$49.8 million Bond Issue and encourage all residents of the City of North Royalton to vote "Yes" on May 6, 2014, to maintain the current tradition of excellence for the students of the School District.

Section 2. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements.

THEREFORE, provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of a majority of all members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
