AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO A COOPERATIVE AGREEMENT WITH THE CITIES OF PARMA AND BROADVIEW HEIGHTS FOR THE SPRAGUE ROAD RESURFACING PROJECT, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS: The cities of North Royalton, Parma and Broadview Heights each desire to cooperate with the other pursuant to the authority of the Constitution and laws of the State of Ohio, including, without limitation, Section 715.02 of the Ohio Revised Code, to provide for the Sprague Road Resurfacing Project to begin at State Road and conclude at Broadview Road; and

WHEREAS: The cities of North Royalton, Parma and Broadview Heights desire to provide for the construction and financing of the cost of the improvement in an efficient and economical manner in order to provide public facilities and services that are necessary for the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the cities of North Royalton, Parma and Broadview Heights whose properties will benefit from the improvement; and

WHEREAS: It is therefore necessary to authorize the Mayor to enter into a cooperative agreement with the cities of Parma and Broadview Heights for this project; and

WHEREAS: Council desires to provide for this authorization.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH ROYALTON,
COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA AND STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

Section 1. The Mayor is hereby authorized to enter into a cooperative agreement with the cities of Parma and Broadview Heights for the Sprague Road Resurfacing Project to begin at State Road and conclude at Broadview Road pursuant to terms and conditions approved by the Director of Law and substantially similar to a copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated as if fully rewritten.

Section 2. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements.

Section 3. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the city, and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary to authorize the Mayor to enter into a cooperative agreement with the cities of Parma and Broadview Heights for the Sprague Road Resurfacing Project to provide for the construction and financing of the cost of the improvement in an efficient and economical manner in order to provide public facilities and services that are necessary for the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the cities of North Royalton, Parma and Broadview Heights whose properties will benefit from the improvement.

THEREFORE, provided this Ordinance receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
