AN ORDINANCE REJECTING ALL BIDS FOR THE “2014 ASPHALT PAVEMENT REHABILITATION WITH ASPHALT OVERLAY FOR JAMES DRIVE, JAY STREET, JULIA DRIVE, HARLEY HILLS DRIVE “STUB” AND HI VIEW DRIVE” IN THE CITY OF NORTH ROYALTON AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO REBID THIS PROJECT, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS: The City of North Royalton has reserved the right to reject all bids relating to the 2014 Asphalt Pavement Rehabilitation with Asphalt Overlay; and

WHEREAS: Problems have arisen with respect to the bids submitted for this project; and

WHEREAS: Council therefore desires to reject all bids submitted and resubmit this project for bidding.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH ROYALTON, COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA AND STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

Section 1. Council hereby rejects all bids relating to the 2014 Asphalt Pavement Rehabilitation with Asphalt Overlay including suppliers bids and hereby authorizes the Mayor to submit this project for rebidding.

Section 2. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements.

Section 3. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the city, and for the further reason that the City of North Royalton desires to begin the construction of the 2014 Asphalt Pavement Rehabilitation with Asphalt Overlay project and it is immediately necessary to rebid this project.

THEREFORE, provided this Ordinance receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
