AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 10-103, STAFFING AND CLASSIFICATION PLAN FOR THE VARIOUS DEPARTMENTS OF THE CITY OF NORTH ROYALTON, SECTION 6, OFFICE ON AGING/HUMAN SERVICES, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS: It has been determined to be necessary to amend Ordinance 10-103 Staffing and Classification Plan for the City of North Royalton to provide for an additional part time Bus Driver for the Office on Aging/Human Services; and

WHEREAS: Council desires to provide for this amendment.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH ROYALTON, COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA AND STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

Section 1. Council hereby amends Ordinance No. 10-103 Staffing and Classification Plan, Section 6, Office on Aging/Human Services, which shall hereinafter read as follows:

Section 6. The **Office on Aging/Human Services** may employ and be staffed by employees classified in the following classifications providing that there shall be no greater number of employees employed in any one classification than specified herein.

| 1) Director | One (1) |
| 2) Senior Outreach Specialist | One (1) |
| 3) Bus Driver (part time) | Two (2) Three (3) |

Section 2. Ordinance No. 10-103 is amended as provided for herein and all other provisions of Section 6 and Ordinance No. 10-103 shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall supersede all previously adopted ordinances in direct conflict herewith.

Section 4. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements.

Section 5. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the city, and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary to amend Ordinance 10-103 to provide for an additional part time Bus Driver for the Office on Aging/Human Services.

THEREFORE, provided this Ordinance receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
