

# THE CITY COUNCIL OF NORTH ROYALTON, OHIO

ORDINANCE NO. 14-85

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF NORTH ROYALTON, PART 14 BUILDING AND HOUSING CODE, TITLE SIX MISCELLANEOUS BUILDING REGULATIONS BY CREATING A NEW CHAPTER 1465 ENTITLED DONATION BINS/BOXES, AND AMENDING CHAPTER 214 GENERAL FEE SCHEDULE, SECTION 214.08 FEES IN THE BUILDING AND HOUSING CODE, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS: It has been determined to be necessary to define and regulate the use and placement of donation bins/boxes located within the City of North Royalton; and

WHEREAS: It is therefore necessary to amend the Codified Ordinances of the City of North Royalton, Part 14 Building and Housing Code, Title Six Miscellaneous Building Regulations by creating a new Chapter 1465 entitled Donation Bins/Boxes, and amending Chapter 214 General Fee Schedule, Section 214.08 Fees in the Building and Housing Code; and

WHEREAS: Council desires to provide for these amendments.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH ROYALTON, COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA AND STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

Section 1. Part 14 Building and Housing Code, Title Six Miscellaneous Building Regulations of the Codified Ordinances of the City of North Royalton is hereby amended by creating a new Chapter 1465 entitled Donations Bins/Boxes which is attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated herein as if fully rewritten.

Section 2. Part 2 Administration Code, Chapter 214 General Fee Schedule, Section 214.08 Fees in the Building and Housing Code of the Codified Ordinances of the City of North Royalton is hereby amended by creating a new paragraph (m) which shall read as follows:

(m) **Other Fees:**  
(1) **Donation Bins/Boxes (each)** **\$100.00/ per year**

Section 3. Part 14 Building and Housing Code, Title Six Miscellaneous Building Regulations and Chapter 214 General Fee Schedule of the Codified Ordinances of the City of North Royalton are hereby amended as provided for herein and all other provisions of Part 14 and Chapter 214 shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall supersede all previously adopted Ordinances in direct conflict herewith.

Section 5. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements.

Section 6. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the city, and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary to define and regulate the use and placement of donation bins/boxes located within the City of North Royalton.

THEREFORE, provided this Ordinance receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
