

# THE CITY COUNCIL OF NORTH ROYALTON, OHIO

## AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING A ONE YEAR EXTENSION OF THE JOINT MUNICIPAL IMPROVEMENT CONSORTIUM'S CONTRACT WITH CARGILL INC., DEICING TECHNOLOGY, FOR THE PURCHASE OF ROAD SALT FOR THE 2014-2015 SEASON, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS: The City of North Royalton is authorized to purchase road salt through its membership in the Joint Municipal Improvement Consortium (JMIC) at a lower rate than if it purchased it on the open market; and

WHEREAS: Council adopted Ordinance 13-75 accepting the bid of Cargill Inc., Deicing Technology through the JMIC, for the supplying of salt for the Service Department of the City of North Royalton for the 2013-2014 season with an optional second year renewal; and

WHEREAS: The bids submitted to the JMIC were consistent with the competitive bidding requirements of the Ohio Revised Code and Charter of the City of North Royalton; and

WHEREAS: Cargill Inc., Deicing Technology has agreed to extend their 2013-2014 contract through October 31, 2015; and

WHEREAS: The city is purchasing this product at a cost which meets or exceeds the specifications of the Ohio Cooperative Purchasing Program of the Department of Administrative Services, as required by House Bill 204; and

WHEREAS: Council wishes to accept the extended contract price of Cargill Inc., Deicing Technology, for bulk road salt.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH ROYALTON, COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA AND STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

Section 1. Council hereby accepts the extended contract price of Cargill Inc., Deicing Technology, through the Joint Municipal Improvement Consortium, for the supplying of salt for the Service Department of the City of North Royalton as the primary source for bulk road salt for the 2014-2015 season as set forth in Exhibit A attached hereto and incorporated as if fully rewritten and which is in accordance with the specifications on file in the Office of the Service Director.

Section 2. The Mayor is hereby authorized and directed to enter into a contract on behalf of the City of North Royalton with Cargill Inc., Deicing Technology, as set forth in Section 1 hereof, said contract to be in such form as is approved by the Director of Law.

Section 3. The Service Director is hereby authorized and directed to forward a certified copy of this Ordinance to Cargill Inc., Deicing Technology.

Section 4. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements.

Section 5. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the city, and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary to provide for the purchase of bulk road salt for the City of North Royalton.

THEREFORE, provided this Ordinance receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
