AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 13-143 AUTHORIZING THE EXPENDITURE OF FUNDS FOR THE PURCHASE OF EQUIPMENT AND SERVICES FOR THE NORTH ROYALTON SERVICE DEPARTMENT THROUGH THE OHIO DEPARTMENT OF ADMINISTRATIVE SERVICES, OHIO COOPERATIVE PURCHASING PROGRAM BY REMOVING THE PURCHASE AND INSTALLATION OF A SNOW PLOW AND ADDING THE PURCHASE AND INSTALLATION OF AN AIR COMPRESSOR AND TAIL GATE LIFT, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS: A contract was executed by and between the City of North Royalton and Concord Road Equipment for the purchase of equipment and services through the Ohio Cooperative Purchasing Program of the Department of Administrative Services; and

WHEREAS: Due to the changing needs of the department, it has become necessary to eliminate the purchase and installation of a snow plow and to add the purchase and installation of an air compressor and tail gate lift at an increased price of \$1,790.76; and

WHEREAS: Council desires to provide for this amendment.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH ROYALTON, COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA AND STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

Section 1. Ordinance 13-143 is hereby amended by eliminating the purchase and installation of a snow plow and adding the purchase and installation of an air compressor and tail gate lift at an increased price of \$1,790.76, for a new contract amount of \$13,769.38 as outlined in Exhibit A attached hereto and incorporated herein as if fully rewritten.

Section 2. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements.

Section 3. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the city, and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary provide for this amendment in order to assure that all changes to this contract are properly recorded to insure accurate record keeping for this purchase.

THEREFORE, provided this Ordinance receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
