AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF NORTH ROYALTON, PART 6 GENERAL OFFENSES CODE, CHAPTER 660 SAFETY, SANITATION AND HEALTH BY CREATING A NEW SECTION 660.22 ELECTRICAL SAFETY, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS: It has been determined to be necessary to incorporate language contained in the National Electric Code pertaining to electrical safety into the Codified Ordinances of the City of North Royalton for the health, safety and welfare of the residents; and

WHEREAS: It is therefore necessary to amend the Codified Ordinances of the City of North Royalton, Part 6 General Offenses Code, Chapter 660 Safety, Sanitation and Health by creating a new Section 660.22 Electrical Safety; and

WHEREAS: Council desires to provide for this amendment.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH ROYALTON, COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA AND STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

Section 1. Part 6 General Offenses Code, Chapter 660 Safety, Sanitation and Health of the Codified Ordinances of the City of North Royalton is hereby amended by creating a new Section 660.22 Electrical Safety which shall hereinafter read as follows:

***660.22 Electrical Safety***

***The current edition of NFPA 70; the National Electric Code, Article 680 shall apply and be enforced for all one-, two- and three-family dwelling outdoor electrical installations servicing the following: swimming, wading, therapeutic, and decorative pools; fountains; hot tubs, spas; and hydromassage bathtubs, whether permanently installed or portable. An electrical permit and the use of a registered electrician shall be required for all such installations.***

Section 2. Chapter 660 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of North Royalton is hereby amended as provided for herein and all other provisions of Chapter 660 shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall supersede all previously adopted Ordinances in direct conflict herewith.

Section 4. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements.

Section 5. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the city, and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary to incorporate language contained in the National Electric Code pertaining to electrical safety into the Codified Ordinances of the City of North Royalton for the health, safety and welfare of the residents.

THEREFORE, provided this Ordinance receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
