AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 07-126 ESTABLISHING VARIOUS BENEFITS FOR ALL FULL TIME NON UNION EMPLOYEES OF THE CITY OF NORTH ROYALTON, BY AMENDING SECTION 14 CLOTHING ALLOWANCE, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS: The City of North Royalton provides benefits for all full time non union employees of the City of North Royalton; and

WHEREAS: Section 14 of Ordinance 07-126 provides for a clothing allowance for certain positions in the Wastewater, Cemetery/Parks, Streets and Rubbish/Recycling Departments; and

WHEREAS: The structure of these positions has changed and are no longer eligible to receive a clothing allowance; and

WHEREAS: It is therefore necessary to amend Ordinance 07-126 establishing various benefits for all full time non union employees of the City of North Royalton, by deleting Section 14 Clothing Allowance; and

WHEREAS: Council desires to provide for this amendment.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH ROYALTON, COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA AND STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

Section 1. Ordinance 07-126, Section 14 Clothing Allowance is hereby deleted in its entirety.

~~Section 14. Clothing Allowance: Each Assistant Superintendent in the Wastewater Department, and each full time non union foreman of the following departments: Wastewater, Cemetery/Parks, Streets and Rubbish/Recycling shall receive an annual clothing allowance in the amount of Two Hundred Seventy Five Dollars (\$275.00) to be paid in the first pay period in January and an equal amount to be paid in July each calendar year. The City shall provide the necessary foul weather gear.~~

Section 2. Ordinance 07-126 is hereby amended as provided for herein and all other provisions of Ordinance 07-126 shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall supersede all previously adopted Ordinances in direct conflict herewith.

Section 4. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements.

Section 5. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the city, and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary to amend Ordinance 07-126 to delete Section 14 Clothing Allowance.

THEREFORE, provided this Ordinance receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
