AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO A LEASE/PURCHASE AGREEMENT WITH HUNTINGTON PUBLIC CAPITAL CORPORATION FOR AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$464,000.00 TO FINANCE THE PURCHASE OF THREE (3) 2016 INTERNATIONAL SINGLE AXLE DUMP TRUCKS FOR THE NORTH ROYALTON SERVICE DEPARTMENT THROUGH THE OHIO DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION PURCHASING CONTRACT FOR AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$260,877.00, AND FOR THE PURCHASE OF SNOW AND ICE CONTROL EQUIPMENT PACKAGES FOR THE NORTH ROYALTON SERVICE DEPARTMENT THROUGH THE OHIO DEPARTMENT OF ADMINISTRATIVE SERVICES, OHIO COOPERATIVE PURCHASING PROGRAM FOR AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$165,964.61, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS: Council has authorized the purchase of replacement vehicles and equipment for the North Royalton Service Department; and

WHEREAS: The city is obtaining these vehicles and equipment through the Ohio Department of Transportation Purchasing Contract and the Ohio Cooperative Purchasing Program of the Department of Administrative Services; and

WHEREAS: The city desires to finance these purchases through a lease/purchase agreement with Huntington Public Capital Corporation for an amount not to exceed \$464,000.00 to be paid in 7 annual installments; and

WHEREAS: Council desires to authorize the Mayor to enter into this lease/purchase agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH ROYALTON, COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA AND STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

Section 1. Council hereby authorizes the Mayor to enter into a lease/purchase agreement with Huntington Public Capital Corporation for an amount not to exceed \$464,000.00 to be paid in 7 annual installments to finance the purchase of three (3) 2016 International single axle dump trucks for the North Royalton Service Department through the Ohio Department of Transportation Purchasing Contract for an amount not to exceed \$260,877.00, pursuant to ODOT Contract No. 023-14, Vendor: Rush Truck Centers, 11775 Highway Drive, Cincinnati, Ohio 45241, Vendor #46-1123337, and for the purchase of snow and ice control equipment packages for the North Royalton Service Department for an amount not to exceed \$165,964.61 pursuant to Contract No. 800116, through the Ohio Cooperative Purchasing Program of the Department of Administrative Services, Vendor: Concord Road Equipment Mfg., Inc., 348 Chester Street, Painesville, Ohio 44077, Vendor #58520, and as further described in Exhibit A attached hereto and incorporated as if fully rewritten.

Section 2. The Finance Director is hereby authorized and directed to forward a certified copy of this Ordinance to Huntington Public Capital Corporation.

Section 3. The Service Director is hereby authorized and directed to forward a certified copy of this Ordinance to Rush Truck Centers and Concord Road Equipment Mfg., Inc.

Section 4. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements.

Section 5. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the city, and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary to provide for the lease/purchase of these vehicles and equipment for the North Royalton Service Department for the proper and immediate performance of departmental duties.

THEREFORE, provided this Ordinance receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
