ORDINANCE NO. 15-66

AN ORDINANCE TO RATIFY AND CONFIRM A CONTRACT BETWEEN THE CITY OF NORTH ROYALTON AND TRI MOR CORPORATION FOR EMERGENCY STREET REPAIR AND REPLACEMENT FOR SCOTTSDALE DRIVE FOR AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$75,000 WITHOUT PUBLIC BIDDING, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS: The City of North Royalton has determined that an emergency exists at Scottsdale Drive requiring immediate repair and replacement to protect the health, safety and welfare of the community; and

WHEREAS: Tri Mor Corporation has executed an agreement attached hereto as Exhibit A to provide all labor and materials and perform the services required; and

WHEREAS: Council therefore wishes to authorize payment to Tri Mor Corporation for an amount not to exceed \$75,000.00 for this work; and

WHEREAS: Council desires to ratify and confirm the agreement identified as Exhibit A.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH ROYALTON, COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA AND STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

Section 1. The health, safety and welfare of the citizens of North Royalton required the emergency repair of sewers, street and aprons on Scottsdale Drive, and that Tri Mor Corporation agreed to perform this emergency work for an amount not to exceed \$75,000.00 as set forth in Exhibit A attached hereto and incorporated as if fully rewritten without public bidding.

Section 2. Council hereby authorizes payment in the amount not to exceed \$75,000.00 to Tri Mor Corporation for this emergency work, authorizes and directs the Finance Director to provide for payment, and does confirm and ratify the agreement attached hereto as Exhibit A.

Section 3. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements.

Section 4. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the city, and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary to provide for payment to Tri Mor Corporation for the emergency repair of Scottsdale Drive affecting the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of North Royalton.

THEREFORE, provided this Ordinance receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all members elected to council, it shall take affect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
