

# THE CITY COUNCIL OF NORTH ROYALTON, OHIO

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ACCEPT A GRANT AWARD FROM THE OHIO BUREAU OF WORKERS' COMPENSATION SAFETY INTERVENTION GRANT PROGRAM IN THE AMOUNT OF \$40,000, AND AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE AND INSTALLATION OF THE APPROVED EQUIPMENT WITHOUT PUBLIC BIDDING FOR AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$144,921.08, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS: The City of North Royalton has been awarded a grant in the amount of \$40,000 from the Ohio Bureau of Workers' Compensation Safety Intervention Grant Program; and

WHEREAS: This grant award has been approved by the Ohio Bureau of Workers' Compensation Safety Intervention Grant Program to be applied towards the purchase and installation of 3 power ambulance cots with accessories, 3 power load systems, 3 mass casualty floor mounts and two stair chairs for the North Royalton Fire Department for a total amount not to exceed \$144,921.08; and

WHEREAS: This equipment is being purchased and installed without public bidding due to the fact that this equipment is available only from single source suppliers, broken down as follows: Stryker Safety: 3 power ambulance cots with accessories, 3 power load systems, 3 mass casualty floor mounts - \$126,089.58; Ferno: two stair chairs - \$14,900.00; Findlay Fire: Installation - \$3,931.50; and

WHEREAS: It is therefore necessary to authorize the Mayor to accept the grant award from the Ohio Bureau of Workers' Compensation Safety Intervention Grant Program and to authorize the purchase and installation of the approved equipment.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH ROYALTON, COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA AND STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

Section 1. The Mayor is hereby authorized to accept the grant award from the Ohio Bureau of Workers' Compensation Safety Intervention Grant Program in the amount of \$40,000.00 and to authorize the purchase and installation without public bidding of 3 power ambulance cots with accessories, 3 power load systems, 3 mass casualty floor mount and two stair chairs for the North Royalton Fire Department for a total amount not to exceed \$144,921.08 pursuant to terms and conditions as approved by the Director of Law and substantially similar to a copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated as if fully rewritten.

Section 2. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements.

Section 3. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the city, and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary to authorize the Mayor to accept the grant award from the Ohio Bureau of Workers' Compensation Safety Intervention Grant Program in the amount of \$40,000.00 and to authorize the purchase and installation without public bidding of the approved equipment for a total amount not to exceed \$144,921.08.

THEREFORE, provided this Ordinance receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
