AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO A LEASE/PURCHASE AGREEMENT WITH PNC EQUIPMENT FINANCE, LLC FOR AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$904,367.34 TO FINANCE THE PURCHASE OF ONE (1) PIERCE VELOCITY 107' ASCENDANT AERIAL LADDER FOR THE NORTH ROYALTON FIRE DEPARTMENT FROM THE OHIO DEPARTMENT OF ADMINISTRATIVE SERVICES, OHIO COOPERATIVE PURCHASING PROGRAM, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS: Council has authorized the purchase of a vehicle for the North Royalton Fire Department; and

WHEREAS: The city is obtaining this vehicle through the Ohio Department of Administrative Services, Ohio Cooperative Purchasing Program; and

WHEREAS: The city desires to finance this purchase through a lease/purchase agreement with PNC Equipment Finance, LLC for an amount not to exceed \$904,367.34; and

WHEREAS: Council desires to authorize the Mayor to enter into this lease/purchase agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH ROYALTON, COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA AND STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

Section 1. Council hereby authorizes the Mayor to enter into a lease/purchase agreement with PNC Equipment Finance, LLC for an amount not to exceed \$904,367.34 to finance the purchase of (1) Pierce Velocity 107' Ascendant Aerial Ladder for the North Royalton Fire Department through the Ohio Department of Administrative Services, Ohio Cooperative Purchasing Program pursuant to Contract No. 800180, Vendor: Finley Fire Equipment, 5255 North State Route 60 NW, McConnelville, Ohio 43756, Vendor No. 43301, and as further described in Exhibit A attached hereto and incorporated as if fully rewritten.

Section 2. The Finance Director is hereby authorized and directed to forward a certified copy of this Ordinance to PNC Equipment Finance, LLC.

Section 3. The Fire Chief is hereby authorized and directed to forward a certified copy of this Ordinance to Finley Fire Equipment.

Section 4. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements.

Section 5. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the city, and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary to provide for the lease/purchase of this vehicle for the North Royalton Fire Department for the proper and immediate performance of departmental duties.

THEREFORE, provided this Ordinance receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
