ORDINANCE NO. 15-118

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO A COOPERATIVE AGREEMENT WITH THE CITY OF PARMA, OHIO FOR THE SPRAGUE ROAD CULVERT REPAIR PROJECT, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS: Parma City Council passed Ordinance No. 125-14, engaging Donald G. Bohning & Associates, Inc. (Bohning) for professional design services for an emergency culvert repair on Sprague Road in August of 2014; and

WHEREAS: The final plans of Bohning were sent to the Cuyahoga County Department of Public Works (CCDPW), who engaged Terrace Construction to complete the repairs pursuant to the final plans and estimates; and

WHEREAS: While the initial repairs were expected to be performed in Parma only, upon a field meeting of the parties on October 1, 2015, it was determined that the repair should be extended into North Royalton, and the repair would be the invert repair (Rehabilitation) of the entire length of the culvert; and

WHEREAS: Council desires to authorize the Mayor to enter into this cooperative agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH ROYALTON, COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA AND STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

Section 1. The Mayor is hereby authorized to enter into a Cooperative Agreement with the City of Parma, Ohio for the Sprague Road Culvert Repair Project pursuant to terms and conditions as approved by the Director of Law and substantially similar to a copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated as if fully rewritten.

Section 2. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements.

Section 3. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the city, and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary to enter into a Cooperative Agreement with the City of Parma, Ohio for the Sprague Road Culvert Repair Project.

THEREFORE, provided this Ordinance receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
