AN ORDINANCE AMENDING PART SIX GENERAL OFFENSES CODE, CHAPTER 628 FAIR HOUSING OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF NORTH ROYALTON, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS: The Fair Housing Review Board of the City of North Royalton met on September 13, 2016 and has recommended amendments to Chapter 628 Fair Housing; and

WHEREAS: It is therefore necessary to amend the Codified Ordinances of the City of North Royalton, Part Six General Offenses Code, Chapter 628 Fair Housing; and

WHEREAS: Council desires to provide for these amendments.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH ROYALTON, COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA AND STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

Section 1. Part Six General Offenses Code, Chapter 628 Fair Housing of the Codified Ordinances of the City of North Royalton is hereby amended as provided for in Exhibit A, a copy of which is attached hereto and incorporated as if fully rewritten.

Section 2. Chapter 628 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of North Royalton is hereby amended as provided for herein and all other provisions of Chapter 628 shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall supersede all previously adopted Ordinances in direct conflict herewith.

Section 4. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements.

Section 5. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the city, and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary to amend Chapter 628 Fair Housing of the Codified Ordinances of the City of North Royalton to provide for the amendments as recommended by the Fair Housing Review Board.

THEREFORE, provided this Ordinance receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
